Oral Health	TGC	Anatomy & Physiology	Mouth, teeth, gums	Caries as infectious disease – how transmitted - periodontal disease/infection relates to preterm labor, possible systemic effects; when teeth erupt, teething, wisdom teeth
		Dietary Management	Recommended diet	Any diet related teaching that effects oral health, e.g, sugar intake and use of bottles beyond 14 months
		Personal Hygiene	Frequent brushing and flossing	Mainly a check item
		Medical/Dental Care	Other <i>Regular, preventive care</i>	Any prevention measures that are not diet related
	Case Management	Medical/Dental Care	Other – assist with finding dental home	Advocacy, referrals, coordination r/t dental/oral health including arranging/assisting with transportation and finding dental home
	Surveillance	Dietary Management	Adequate/appropriate for age/physical status	S & O r/t diet and risk of caries i.e. high sugar, prolonged sugar exposure on teeth, use of bottled water, soda pop
		Medical/Dental Care	Adequate/appropriate	S & O r/t dental appts/care
		S/s physical	Evidence of Disease/infection	Pain, odor, decay
