

Omaha System Pathway Development

School-based Services for Adolescents

Discussion: This pathway was designed for use by local health department PHNs assigned to area high schools specifically to provide family planning counseling, pregnancy testing, and referral. The Omaha System problem *Health Care Supervision* was chosen because this purpose of this program is to provide access to health care for sexually active adolescents. Many referrals are made to health care providers and community counseling resources. The group wanted to use only one Omaha System problem to streamline charting for the brief visits, and felt that the broad topic of health care supervision was the best fit. If the client was receiving more intensive services, other problems would be opened and addressed by the nurse. One advantage of using the Health Care Supervision problem for this pathway is that interventions won't overlap with other standard interventions in the Wright County pathways.
