	Surveillance	Medical/ dental care	Other – health care, family planning	S & O related to health care, family planning, medical, dental care
	TGC	Medical/ Dental Care	Routine/preventive care	Immunizations, well child checks
	CM	Other Community Resources	Other - Family resources	Referral, advocacy, communication with resources r/t parenting e.g. crisis nursery, ECFE, support group, MOMs, Family Learning, Follow Along, ECSE
	TGC	Feeding Procedures	Other – methods, amounts, frequency	Breast, formula, solids, preparation, timing, techniques, bottle and nipple care, requirements for age (<i>Surveillance is under child</i>)
	Surveillance	Caretaking/ parenting skills	Other - Physical caretaking	S & O r/t caretaking e.g. discipline, safety, supervision, diapering, hygiene, sleep routines
	TGC	Caretaking /Parenting Skills	Other - Physical caretaking	Handwashing, skin care, diapering, hygiene, cord and circumcision care, sleep routines
	Surveillance	Bonding/Attachment	Other – Parental sensitivity, social-emotional and cognitive growth fostering	Sensitivity, reading and responding to cues, evidence of empathy with child, consistency of response, social-emotional and cognitive growth fostering, S and O r/t relationship including cultural beliefs, interaction including discipline
	TGC	Bonding/Attachment	Other - Parent-child interaction	NCAST, Keys to Caregiving, Seeing is Believing, ASQ activities, GGK and PMMH that pertain to stimulation/play; Reading, singing, reading cues and states, state modulation
	Surveillance	Safety	Environmental safety	S & O r/t safety practices, home safety check
	TGC	Safety	Other – sleep, home, shaken baby	Back to sleep, shaken baby, car seat, passenger safety, prevention of burns, falls, poisoning, drowning, cuts, choking; firearm safety, strangers
	TGC	Growth & Development Care	Realistic expectations	Physical growth, newborn characteristics, developmental progression, milestones, brain development
	TGC	Discipline	Age/condition-appropriate measures	<i>Nurturing practices that promote appropriate behavior, conduct and self-control</i> e.g. Behavior consequences, distraction, choices, limit setting, time out, clear expectations, routines, modeling positive behavior
	TGC	Sickness/ Injury Care	Recognition/Care of sick child/ adult	Recognizing and responding to illnesses or injuries, first aid, emergency care, temp taking, symptomatic treatment of routine illnesses, med administration methods

	Surveillance	Coping Skills	Adaptation/flexibility to demands	S&O r/t managing/coping with parenting, ADLs (jobs,school), and any current issues
	TGC	Coping Skills	Other - Managing life	Decision making, problem solving, prioritizing, managing stress; emotional reactivity/regulation, self esteem; PMMH Unit 4 Relaxation and Wellbeing, & Unit 5 Honoring the Woman in Me
	Surveillance	Support Systems	Other - FOB, formal and informal supports; Relationships	S&O r/t family, friends, associates and those relationships
	TGC	Support Systems	Other – FOB, formal and informal supports; relationships	Accessing support, support needs, PMMH Unit 6 Making Space Father's role
